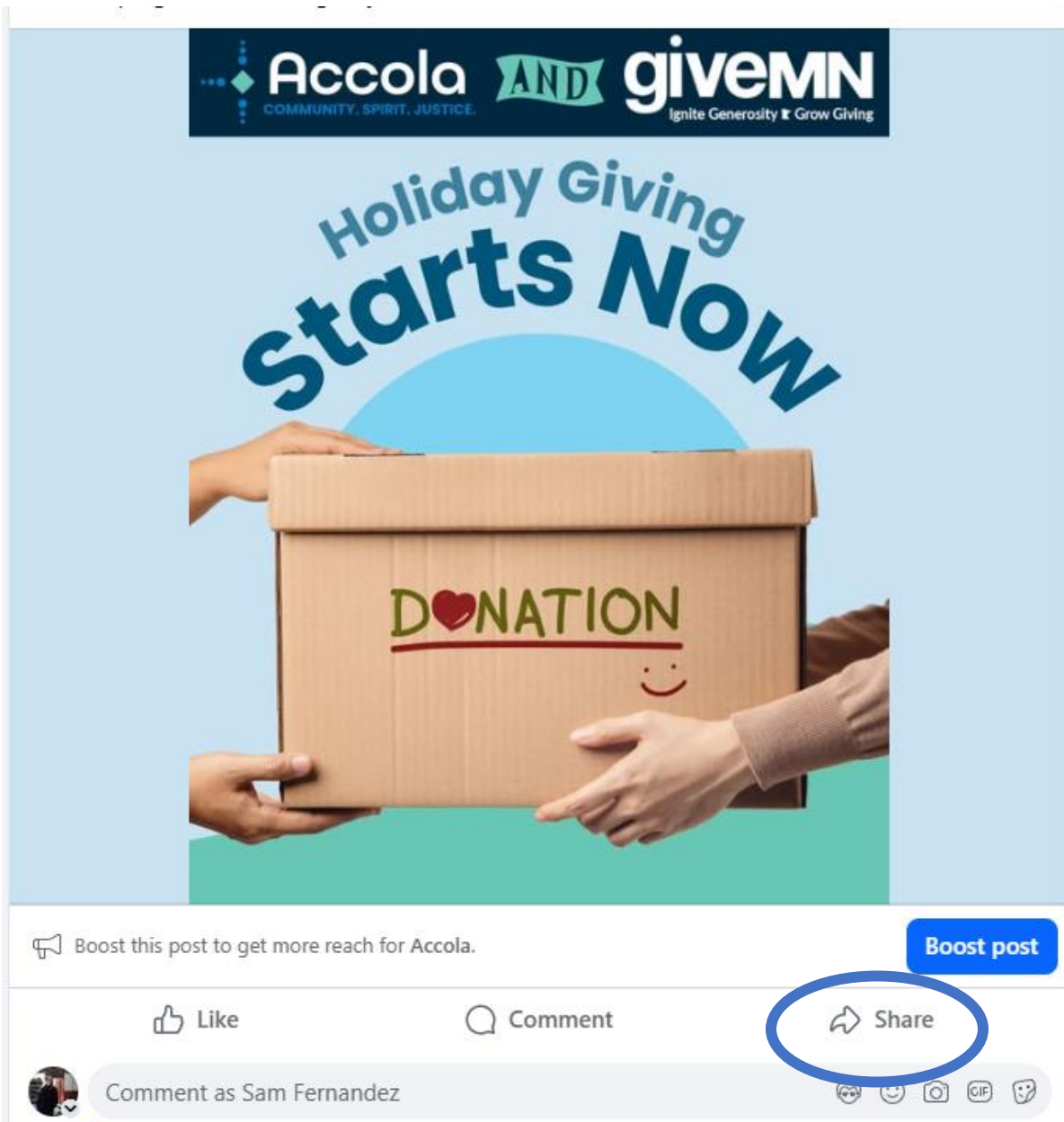

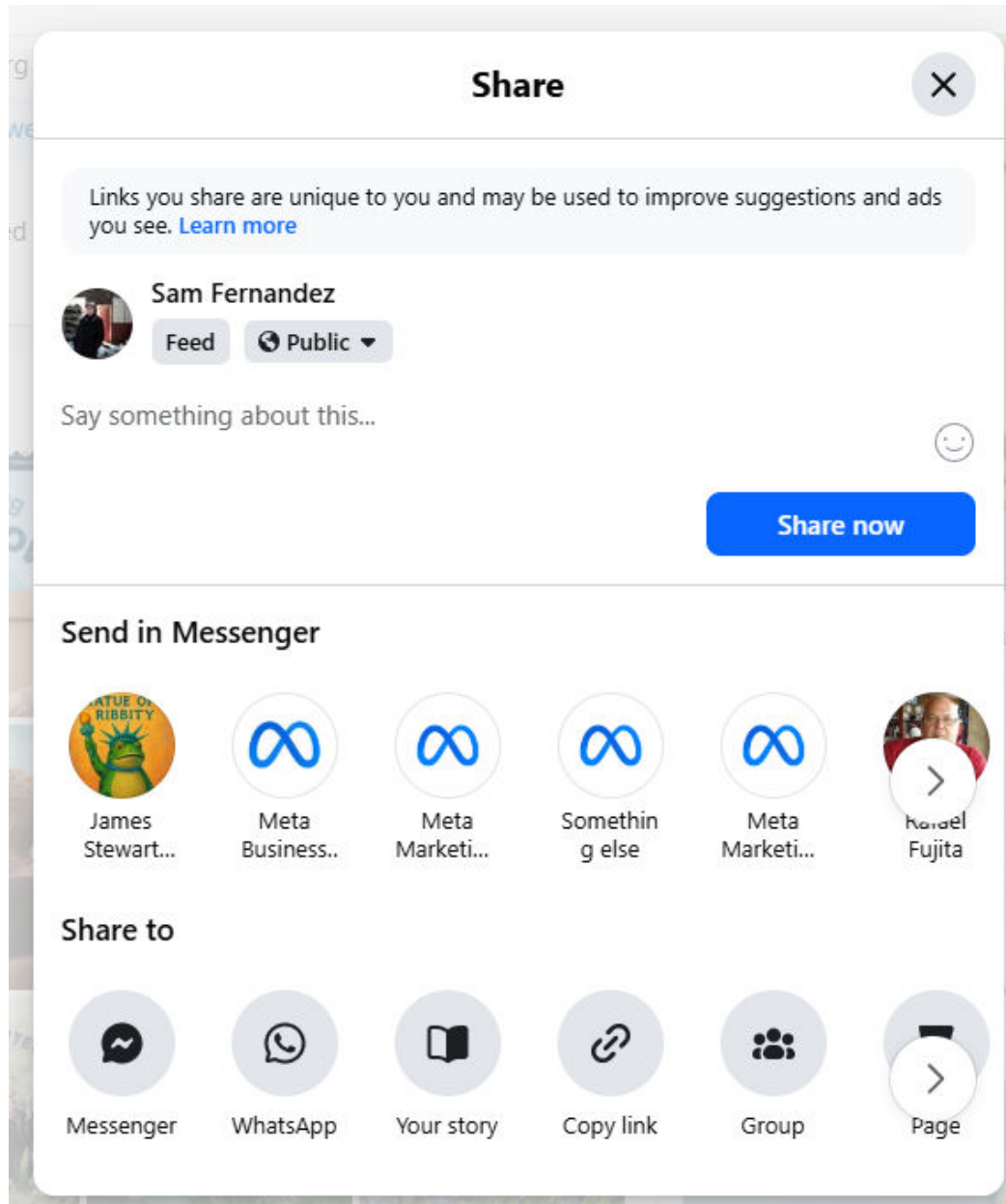

3. On Page Posts, Click “Share”



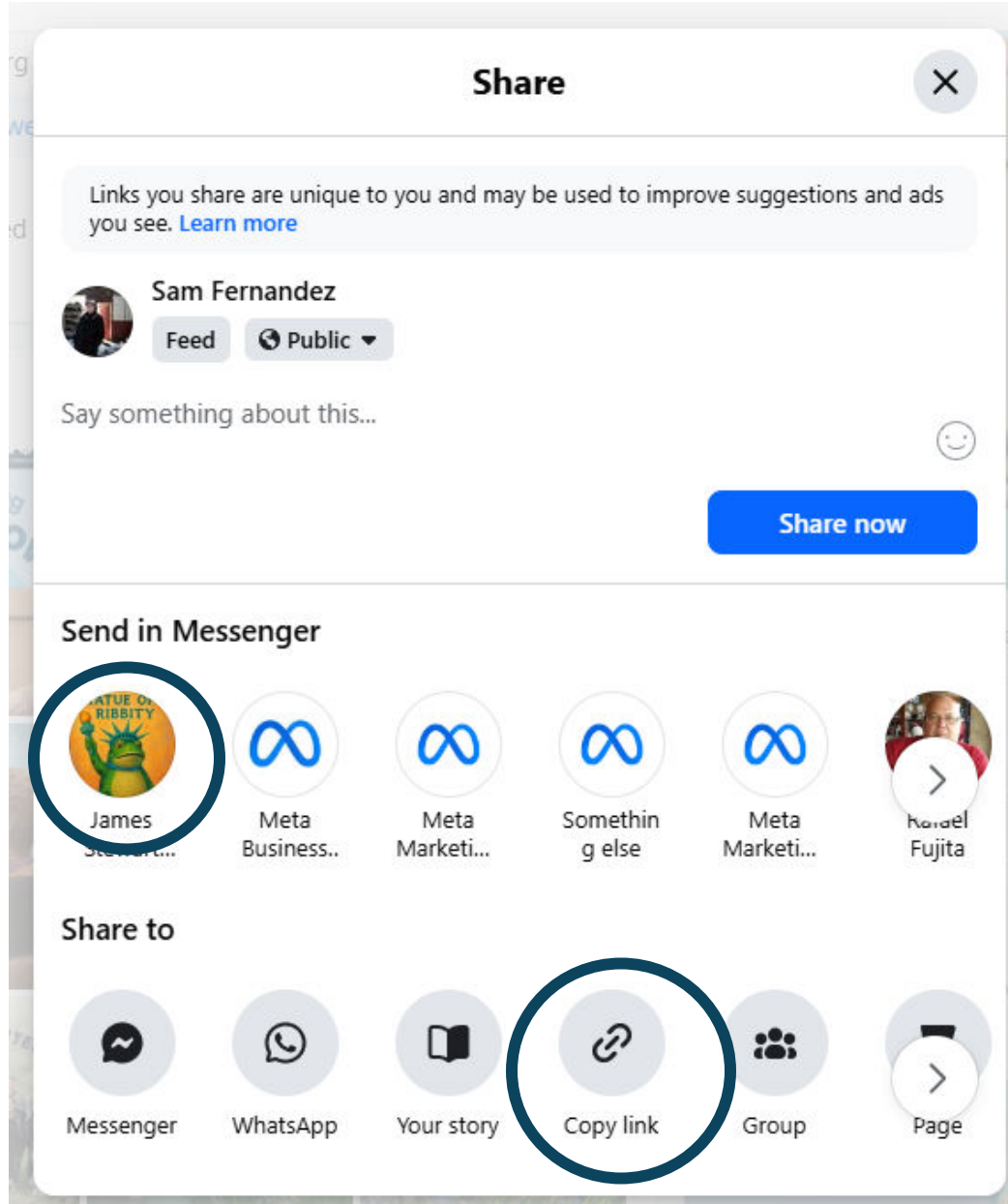
4. When you Click “Share” a box will appear with a few options

5b. If you'd like, you can also share to specific friends/family in messenger, OR share the direct link to the post.

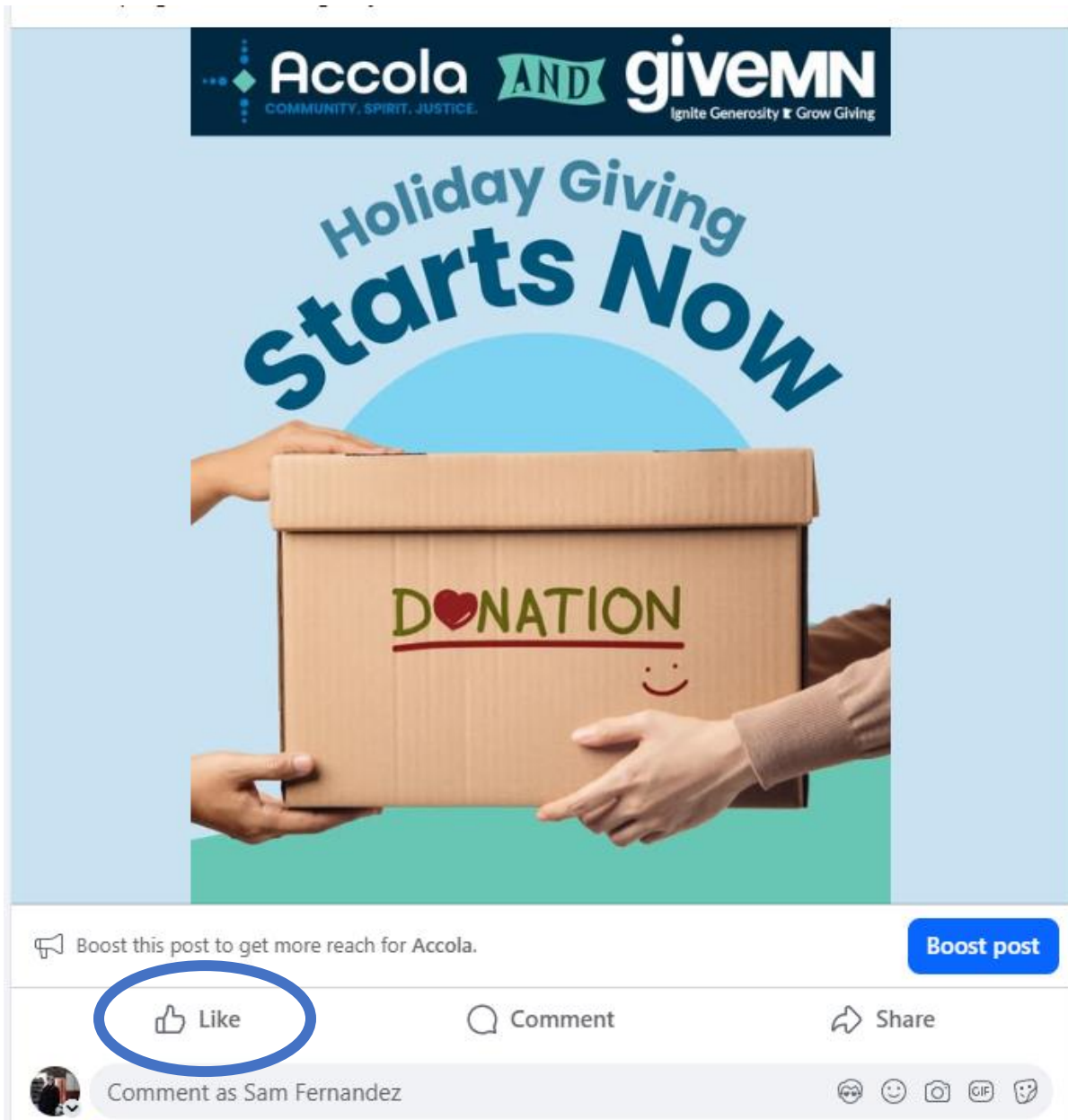

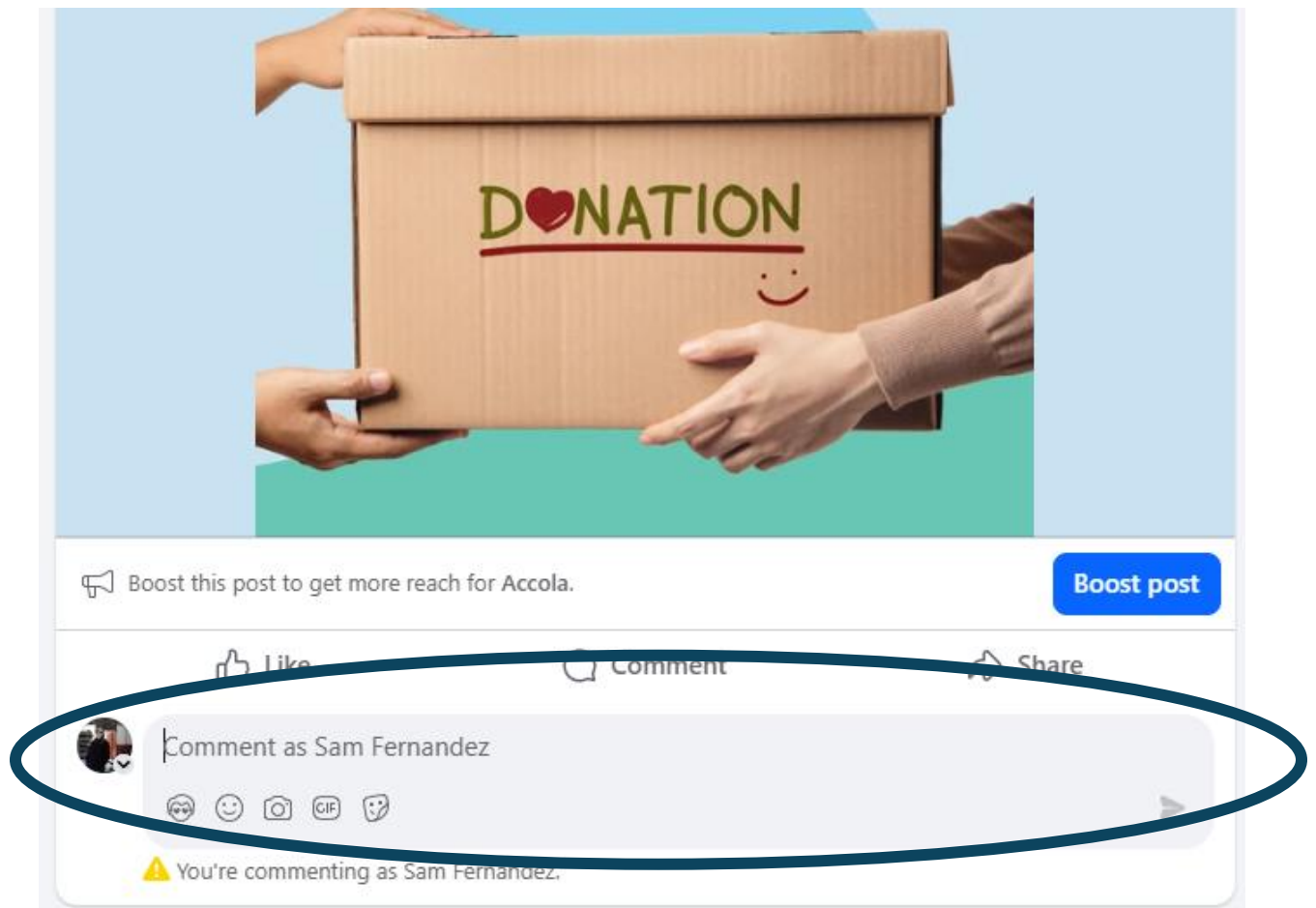

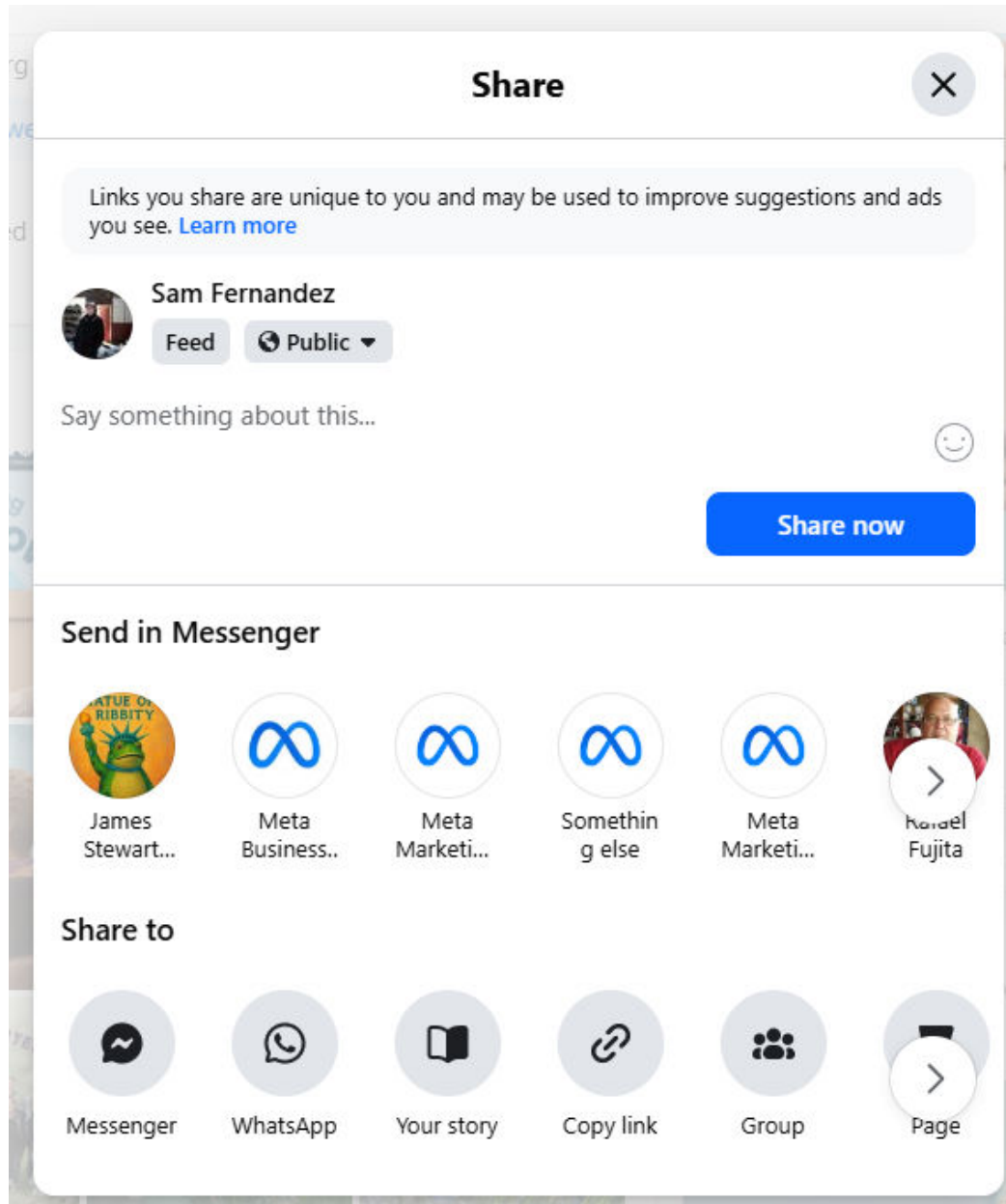

2. If you'd like to comment, Click that too! It will expand to what you see below, allowing you to comment on the post:



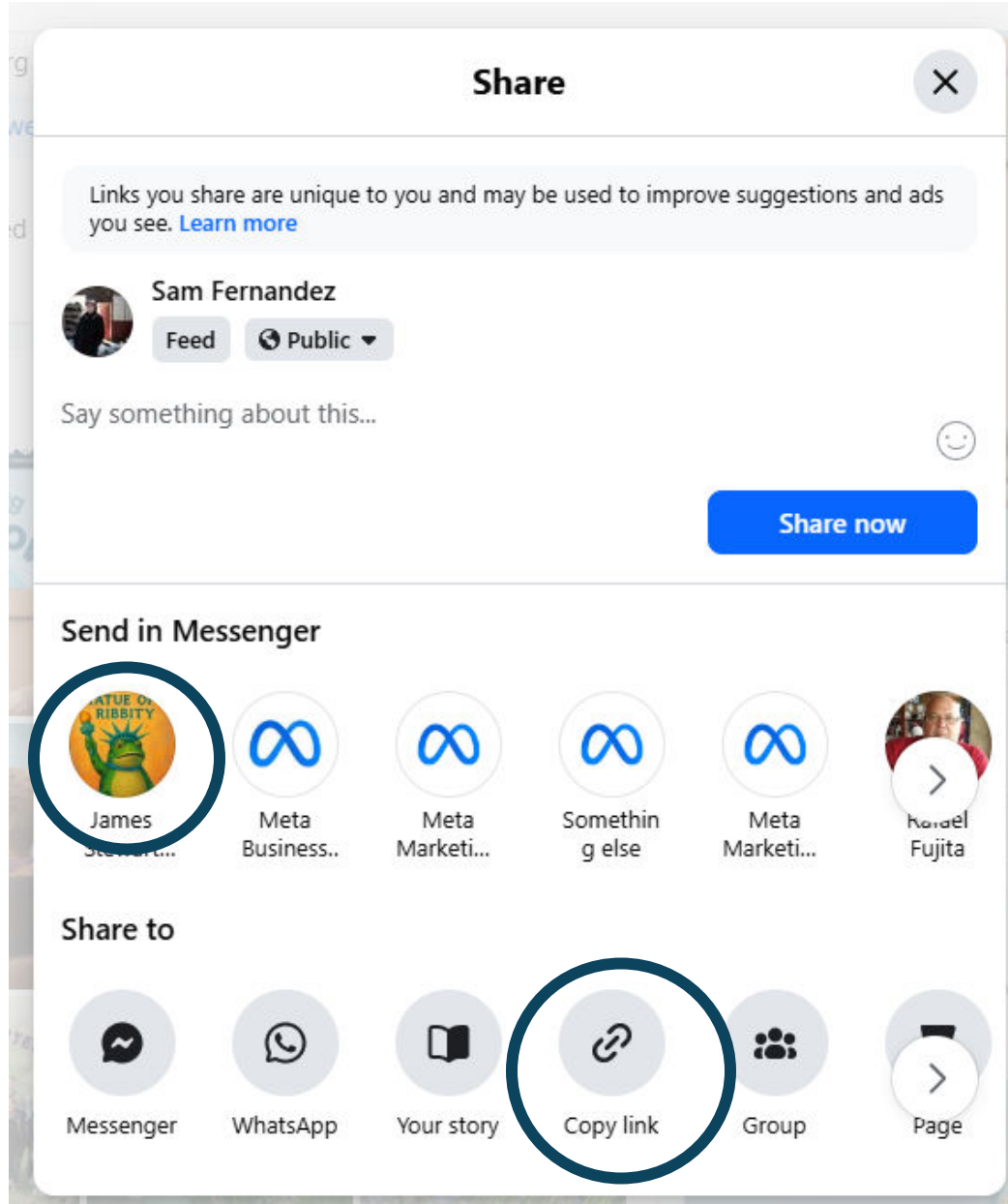
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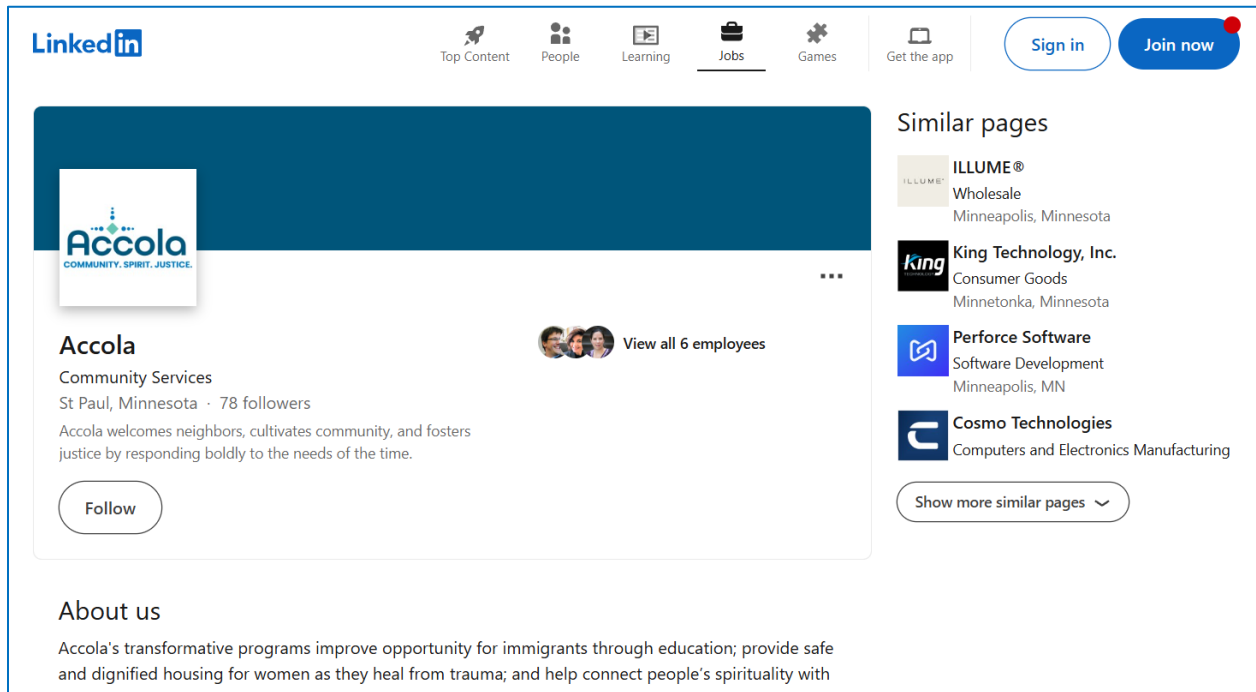

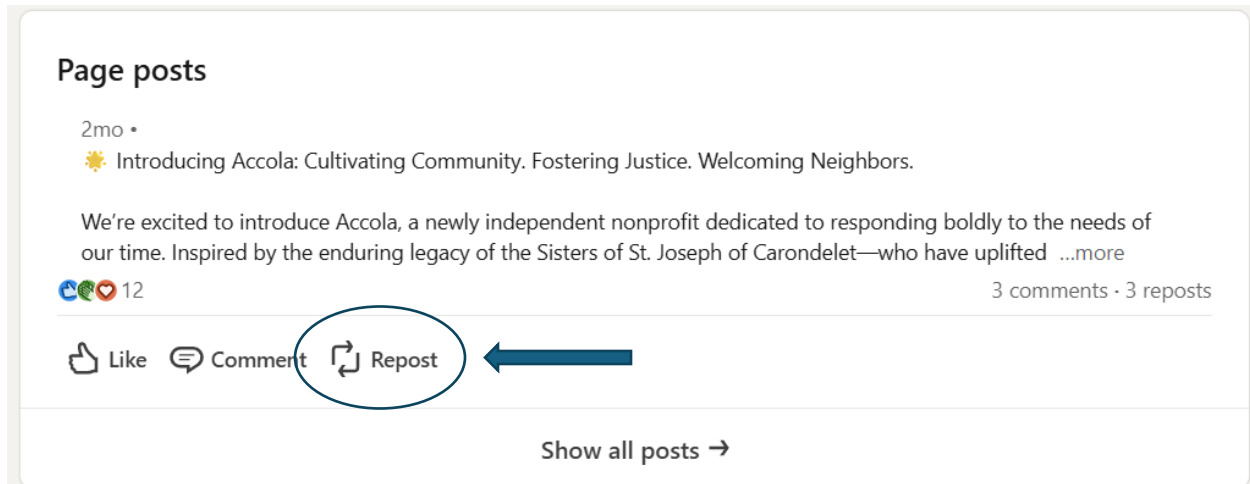

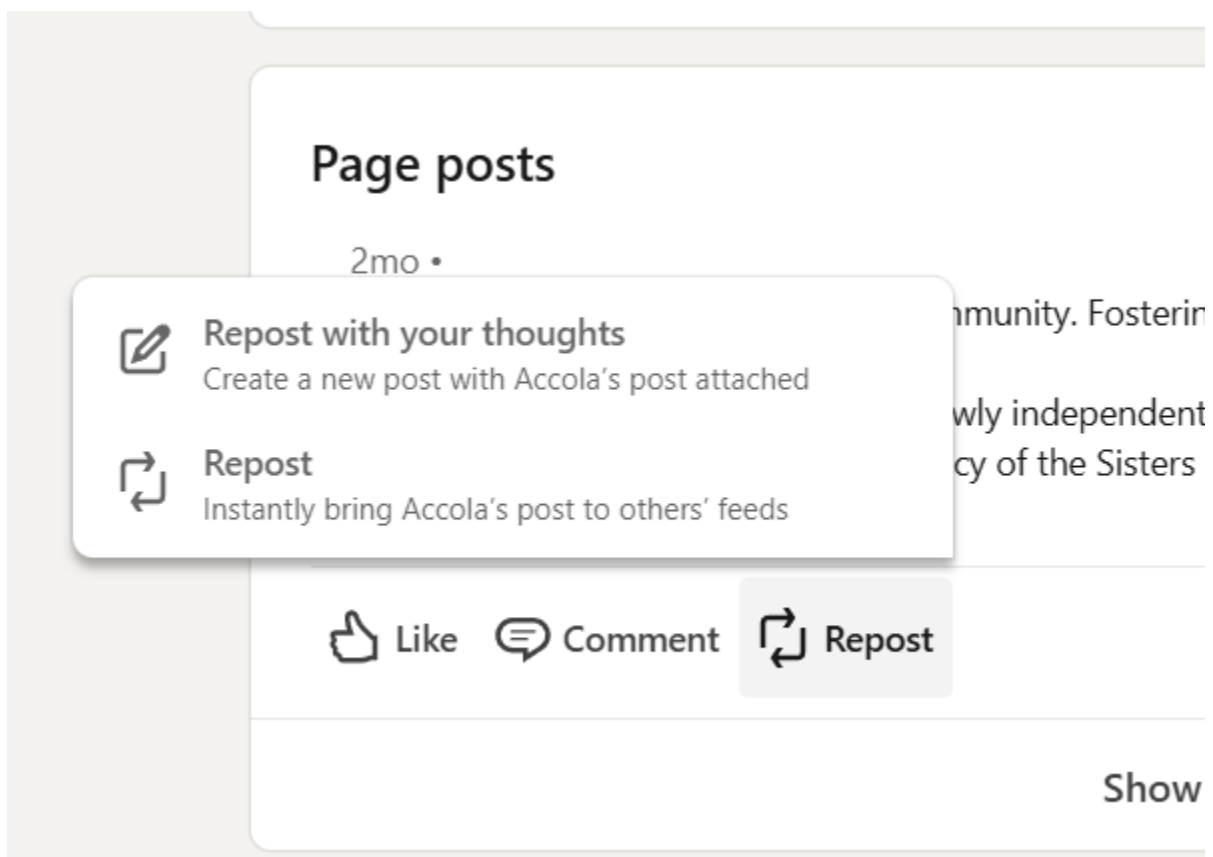

3. On Page Posts, Click “Repost”

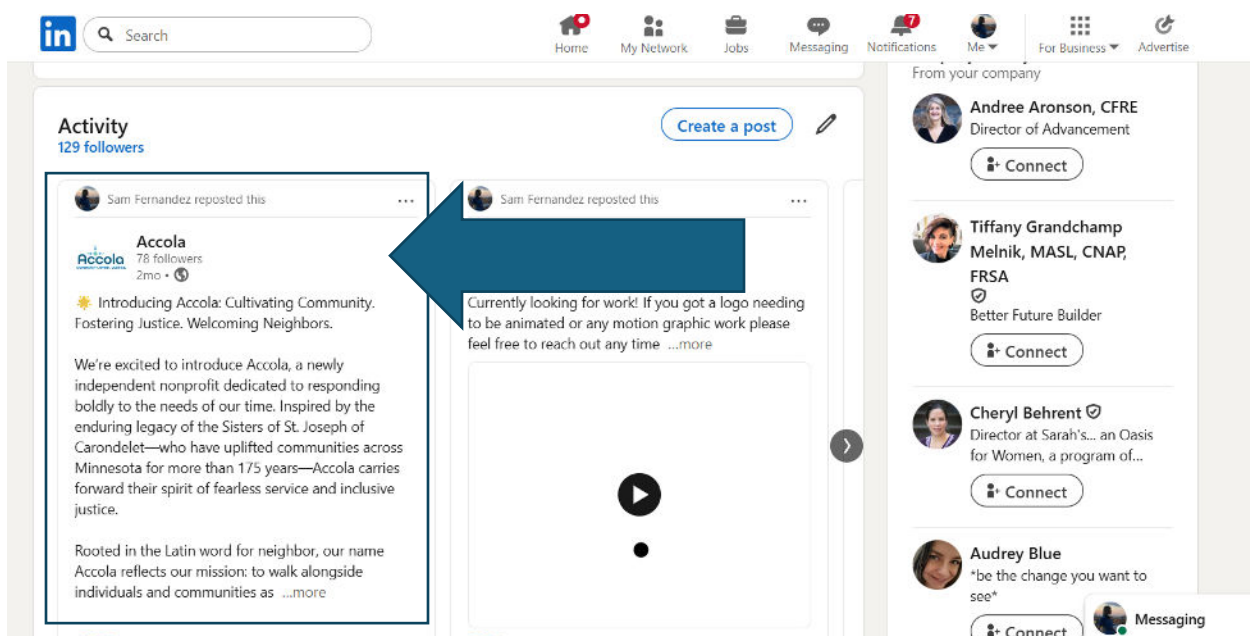


4. When you Click “*Repost*” a box will appear with two options

We are inspired by the enduring mission of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet—who have uplifted communities across Minnesota for more than 175 years—Accola carries forward their spirit of fearless service and inclusive justice.

Our name Accola (Latin for Neighbor) reflects our mission: to walk alongside individuals and communities as compassionate partners and powerful advocates. I LOVE that we're
